Thank you for your interest in Show & Shine 2010, our Customer Appreciation Day and Charity Raffle in support of Susan G. Komen for the Cure. As you probably know, Show & Shine 2010 is scheduled for Sunday, October 3, from 8 am to 2 pm (rain or shine) at our facilities in Portsmouth, New Hampshire. On the back of this letter you will find some information which may be helpful to you, including directions to our facilities and the names and numbers of a few places to spend the night or have a nice meal. There are literally dozens upon dozens of other motels and restaurants in the area (the NH seacoast is a popular destination) so don't feel as if you're limited to what's on the list. If you plan on spending the night in the area, we advise making room reservations as soon as possible. If you wait till the last minute, motels rooms can be hard to find locally; Show & Shine often coincides with Homecoming or Parent's Weekend at the nearby University of New Hampshire. Plus, early October is peak foliage season.

The parking lot is scheduled to open at 8 am. Only BMWs and MINIs will be allowed on the grounds. There is a maximum capacity of 300 cars. (Additional parking is available nearby.) Our showroom will be open from 8 am to 2 pm featuring special deals for the day. A free BBQ lunch will be served at noon. Throughout the day there will be live demos, and we will draw winners in both the free raffle (anyone can enter; must be present to win) and our Charity Raffle (\$5 per ticket, or 5 for \$20; you need not be present to win). ## Directions:

From the North or South:

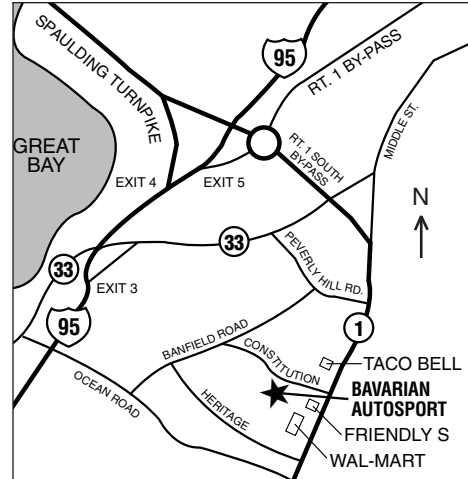
1. Take I-95 to Exit 5 (US Rt.1, Portsmouth Traffic Circle).
2. Enter traffic circle and take exit for Rt. 1 Bypass - South (in front of all the billboards)
3. Go about 3 miles, past Burger King on left, through the lights at Southgate Plaza.
4. Take next right (about 100 yards past lights, between Taco Bell and Friendly's) onto Constitution Ave. We're 1/2 mile down on the left.

From the East (Manchester, NH):

1. Take Route 101 East to I-95 North.
2. Follow directions for North/South above.

From the East (Concord, NH):

1. Take Route 4 East/Spaulding Turnpike to Portsmouth Traffic Circle.
2. Follow directions for North/South from step 2.
